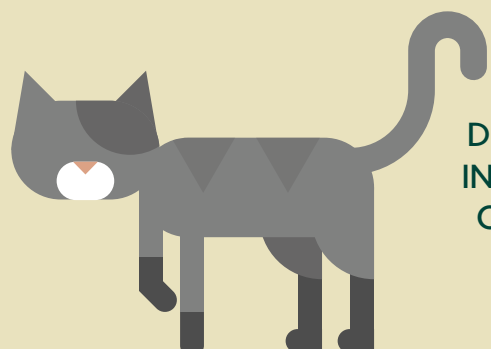


GUIDE TO GETTING A KITTEN

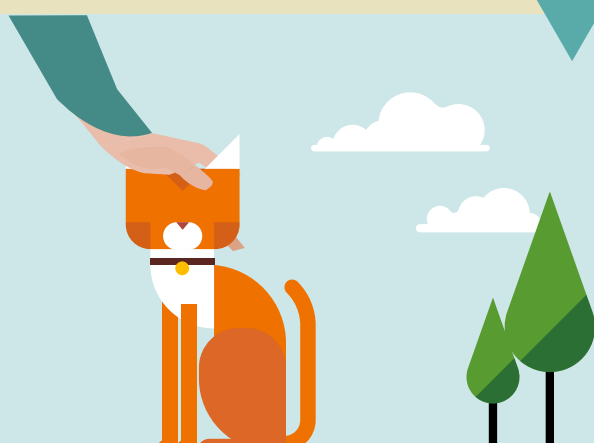
BUYING OR REHOMING?

- How much time will you have for your pet?



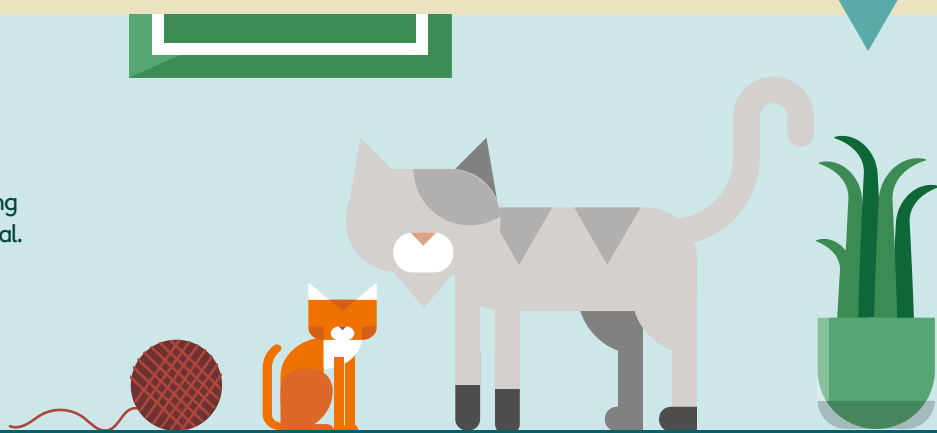
CONSIDER THE BREED OF THE KITTEN

The breed of your cat is going to have a big impact on its behaviour: Some cats are climbers (e.g. Siamese), others need more grooming (e.g. Persians). Bear this in mind!



CONSIDER THE AGE

Consider the age of the cat you'll take in. A kitten will need a lot of training and more play time than an older animal. Also, cats aren't born litter trained, it takes time and patience!



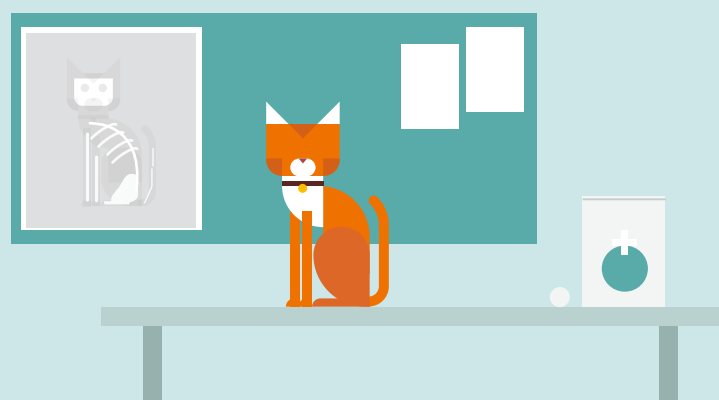
