WHEN IT COMES TO KEEPING YOUR CAT'S COAT TANGLE-FREE, THEY WILL NEED A HAND FROM YOU. WE'VE GATHERED SOME TIPS TO HELP YOU KEEP YOUR PET CLEAN AND HAPPY. REMEMBER, IF YOUR CAT DOES NOT LIKE BATHS, YOU CAN ALWAYS TRY USING AN INFLATABLE PADDLING POOL OUTSIDE.

BRUSHING TIPS:

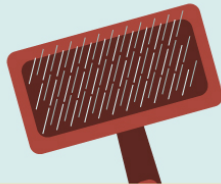


CHECK FOR TICKS & FLEAS AS YOU BRUSH

YOU MAY NOTICE THE BUGS THEMSELVES OR SMALL BLACK FLECKES. REGULARLY TREAT YOUR PET WITH A PREVENTATIVE TICK & FLEA TREATMENT.

USE A FINE-TOOTHED COMB FOR SHORT-HAIRED CATS

USE A BRISTLE OR SOFT RUBBER BRUSH TO REMOVE LOOSE HAIR.



USE A WIDE-TOOTHED COMB TO REMOVE DEBRIS IN LONG-HAIRED CATS' COATS

CONSIDER USING A CLEAN TOOTHBRUSH TO BRUSH THE CAT'S FACE.

IDEALLY BRUSH YOUR LONG-HAIRED CAT EVERYDAY

SHORT-HAIRED CATS CAN BE BRUSHED TWICE A WEEK.



BATHING TIPS:



CATS DON'T OFTEN NEED THE HELP OF A FULL-BLOWN BATH

IF YOUR CAT'S COAT STARTS TO GET STICKY OR DIRTY, A BATH MAY BE NECESSARY.

WHEN BATHING, MAKE SURE THE WATER LEVEL IS LOW

NEVER SPRAY OR POUR WATER DIRECTLY ON YOUR CAT'S HEAD, ONLY GENTLY WET THEIR HEAD AND THEN, SHAMPOO.



MOST CATS ARE NOT BIG FANS OF BATHING

IF YOURS IS ONE OF THEM, YOU CAN CONSIDER CLEANING THE COAT BY GENTLY RUBBING WITH A DAMP CLOTH.
